MALLABULA
Meaning "three swamps", Mallabula was a collection of fishing huts on the foreshore and near the jetty until the 1960s. Then the flat was cleared for sandmining and trees were not replanted so that a housing estate could be developed. The barge used in the sandmining was floated out along a channel cut through the beach near Caswell Reserve, around Tanilba Point, and into another channel cut in the sea wall on Big Swan Bay, to commence sandmining operations there in 1970's and again in 1990's.

MALLABULA / ROOKES POINT

Start at: Caswell Reserve
Distance: 2km.
Surface: waterfront reserve - note houses built during the Depression. Views over Tanilba Bay. Walk down track to water. Views of Port Stephens. Koalas. Move around water to the jetty where there is a tide monitor. Return same way or by road.

MALLABULA TO LTP WATERFRONT WALK

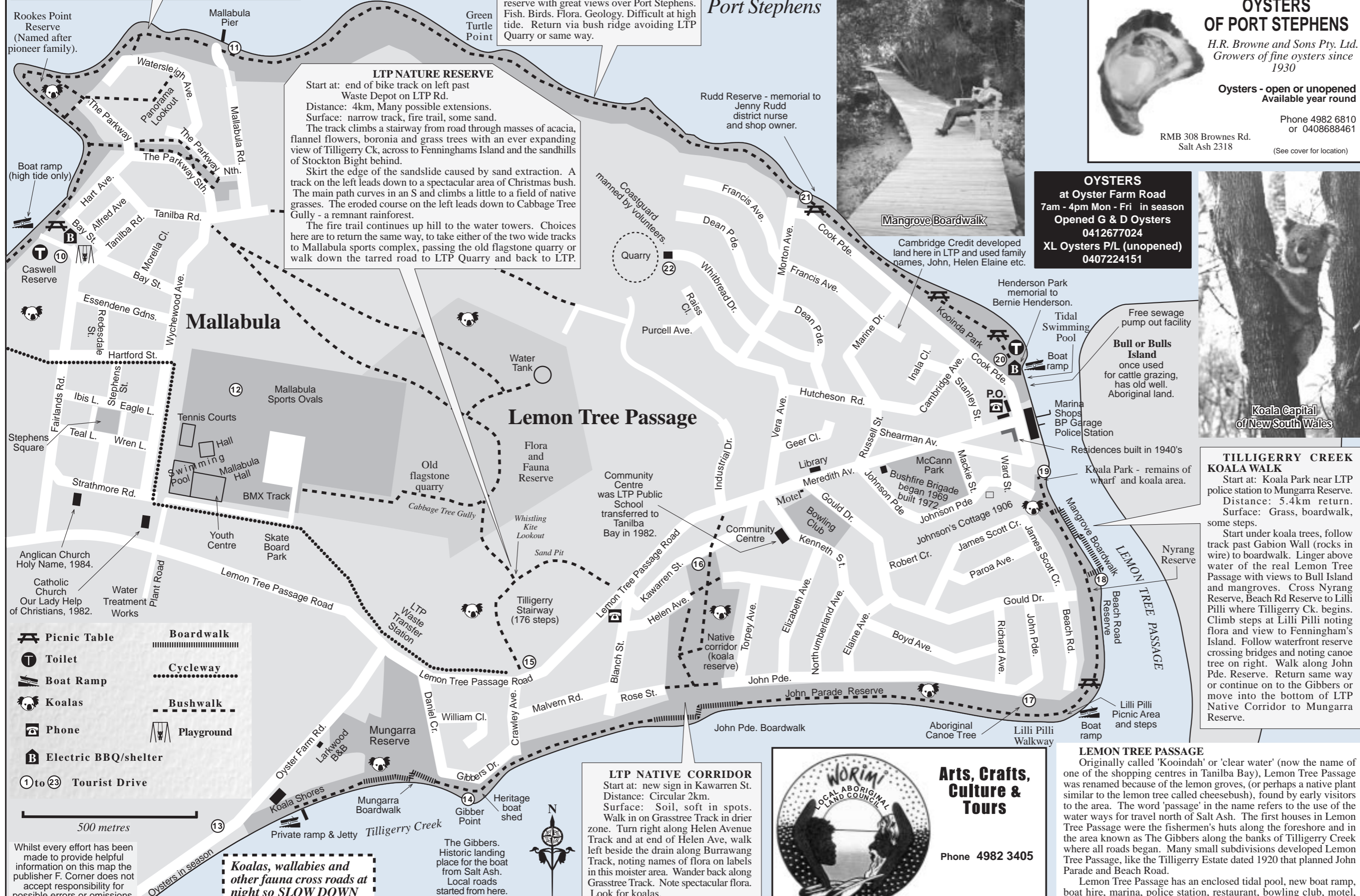
Start at: Mallabula Jetty or Rudd Reserve
Distance: 4km one way. Allow 2 hours.
Surface: best at low tide on rock or sand.
Fabulous walk following the water on reserve with great views over Port Stephens. Fish. Birds. Flora. Geology. Difficult at high tide. Return via bush ridge avoiding LTP Quarry or same way.

LTP NATURE RESERVE

Start at: end of bike track on left past Waste Depot on LTP Rd.
Distance: 4km. Many possible extensions.
Surface: narrow track, fire trail, some sand.
The track climbs a stairway from road through masses of acacia, flannel flowers, boronia and grass trees with an ever expanding view of Tilligerry Ck, across to Fenninghams Island and the sandhills of Stockton Bight behind.
Skirt the edge of the sandslide caused by sand extraction. A track on the left leads down to a spectacular area of Christmas bush. The main path curves in an S and climbs a little to a field of native grasses. The eroded course on the left leads down to Cabbage Tree Gully - a remnant rainforest.
The fire trail continues up hill to the water towers. Choices here are to return the same way, to take either of the two wide tracks to Mallabula sports complex, passing the old flagstone quarry or walk down the tarred road to LTP Quarry and back to LTP.

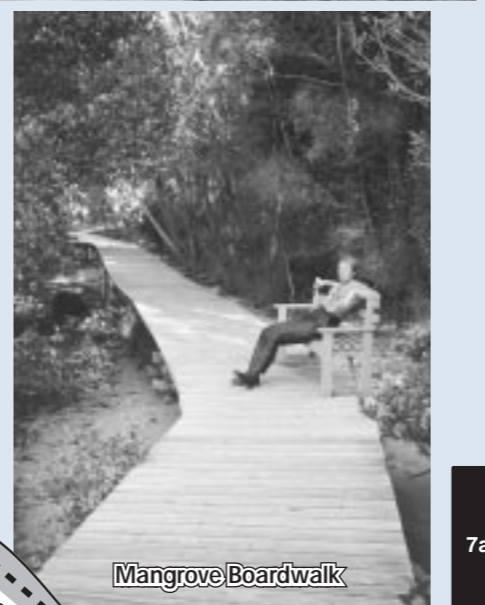
LTP NATIVE CORRIDOR

Start at: new sign in Kawarren St.
Distance: Circular 2km.
Surface: Soil, soft in spots.
Walk in on Grasstree Track in drier zone. Turn right along Helen Avenue Track and at end of Helen Ave, walk left beside the drain along Burrarawang Track, noting names of flora on labels in this moister area. Wander back along Grasstree Track. Note spectacular flora. Look for koalas.

Rudd Reserve - memorial to Jenny Rudd district nurse and shop owner.



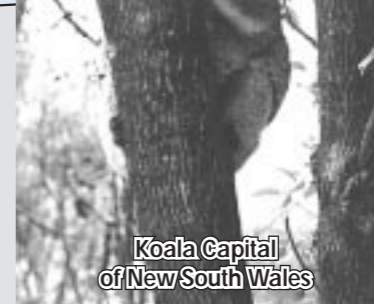

TILLIGERRY CREEK KOALA WALK

Start at: Koala Park near LTP police station to Mungarra Reserve. Distance: 5.4km return. Surface: Grass, boardwalk, some steps.
Start under koala trees, follow track past Gabion Wall (rocks in wire) to boardwalk. Linger above water of the real Lemon Tree Passage with views to Bull Island and mangroves. Cross Nyrang Reserve, Beach Rd Reserve to Lilli Pilli where Tilligerry Ck. begins. Climb steps at Lilli Pilli noting flora and view to Fenningham's Island. Follow waterfront reserve crossing bridges and noting canoe tree on right. Walk along John Pde. Reserve. Return same way or continue on to the Gibbers or move into the bottom of LTP Native Corridor to Mungarra Reserve.

LEMONTREE PASSAGE

Originally called 'Kooindah' or 'clear water' (now the name of one of the shopping centres in Tanilba Bay), Lemon Tree Passage was renamed because of the lemon groves, (or perhaps a native plant similar to the lemon tree called cheesebush), found by early visitors to the area. The word 'passage' in the name refers to the use of the water ways for travel north of Salt Ash. The first houses in Lemon Tree Passage were the fishermen's huts along the foreshore and in the area known as The Gibbers along the banks of Tilligerry Creek where all roads began. Many small subdivisions developed Lemon Tree Passage, like the Tilligerry Estate dated 1920 that planned John Parade and Beach Road.
Lemon Tree Passage has an enclosed tidal pool, new boat ramp, boat hire, marina, police station, restaurant, bowling club, motel, parks, post office, Community Centre, library, real estate agents and takeaway food outlets.
